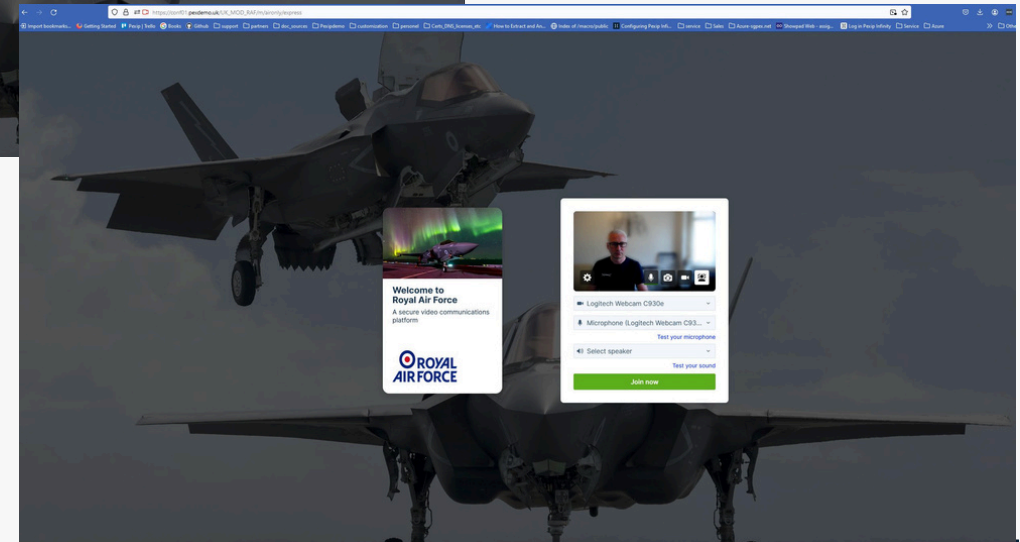
Path-based Branding – standard flow to joining

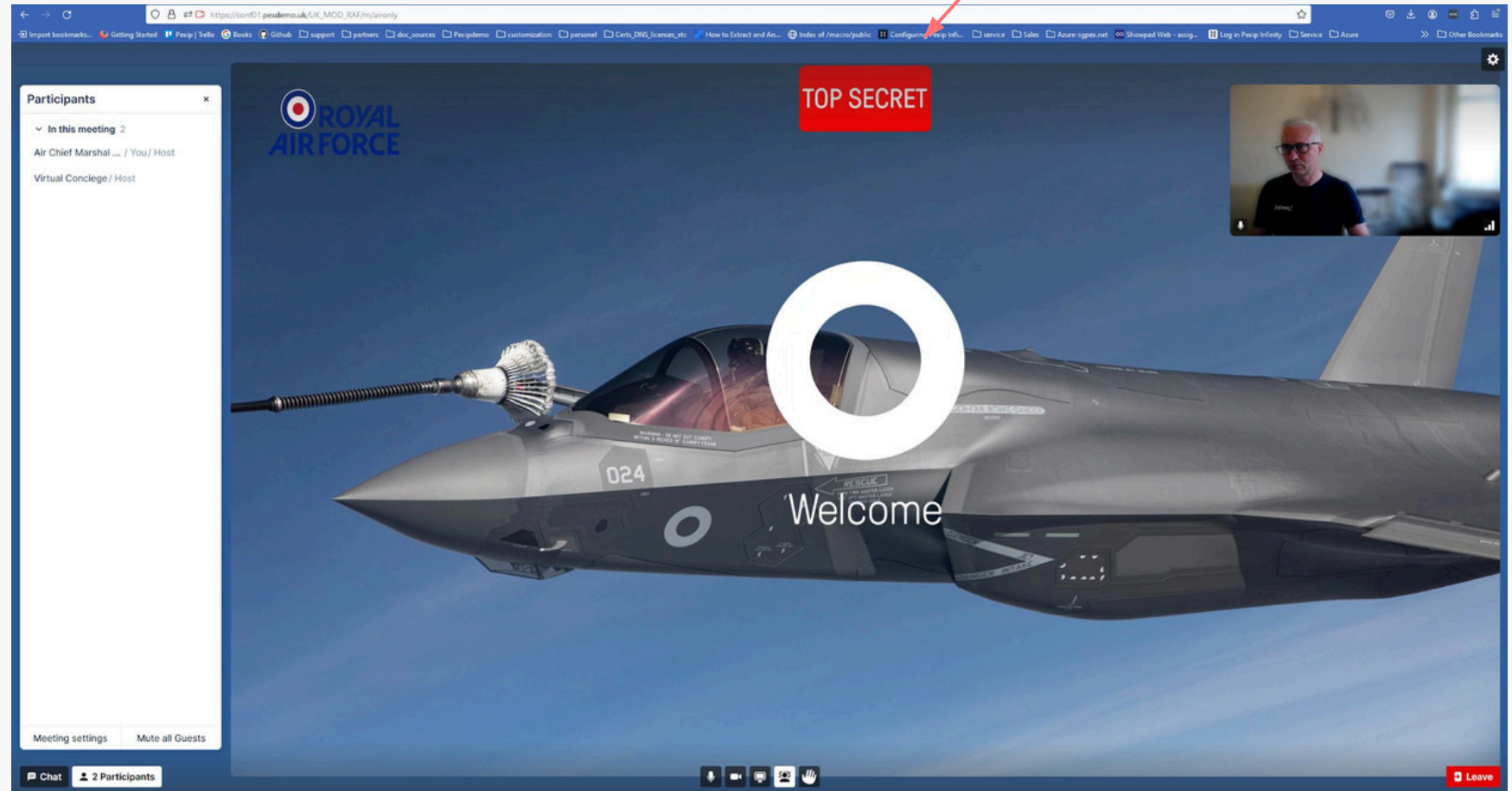

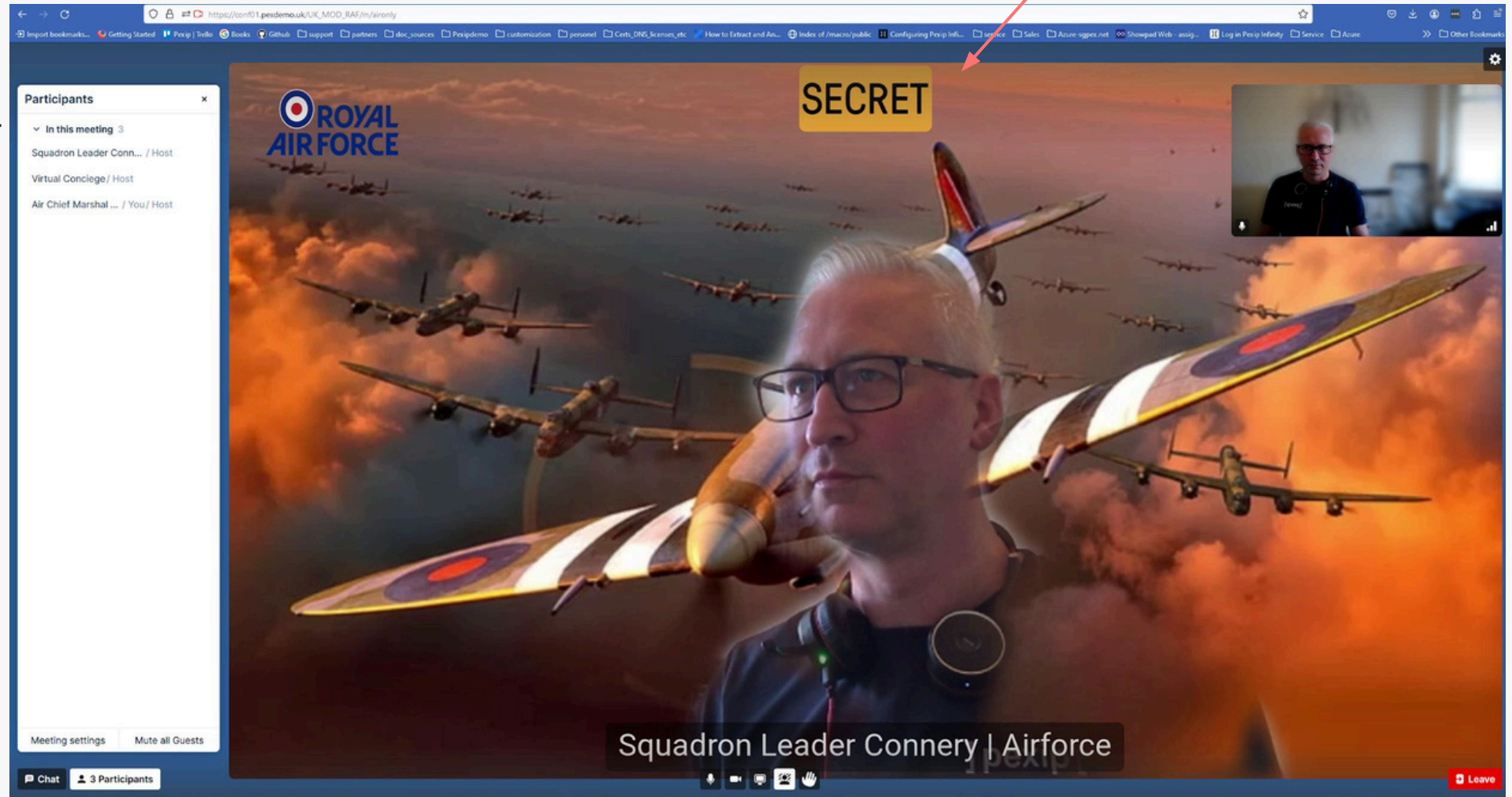
